Smiles Foundation is an international network of three registered charities in the Dominican Republic, Canada, and the United States, united by one mission: to create Brighter Smiles Around the World.

For over 40 years, we have empowered children, families, and communities through accessible oral care, health education, and active living programs. Our work began in the Dominican Republic, where we operate 10 permanent clinics and mobile units, providing free dental care to children and community-based wellness programs.

Through Smiles Foundation in Canada and Smiles Foundation USA, we support and expand this impact by coordinating donations, equipment, and volunteers, as well as leading initiatives like *Smiles in Action*, bringing active lifestyle programs to communities across Canada.

Founded and led by Elina Katsman, Smiles Foundation is driven by compassion, collaboration, and a deep commitment to health equity and human dignity.



U.S.A. - DONATIONS

While donations from the United States experienced a 24.68% decrease in 2025 compared to 2024, Smiles Foundation USA remained focused on maximizing impact through strategic partnerships and efficient resource allocation.


D.R. - “SONRISAS” DENTAL CLINICS

“Sonrisas” Dental Clinics, both permanent and mobile, are at the core of La Fundación para la Prevención y la Salud bucal de los Niños, Inc.’s mission to provide accessible, high-quality oral health care to underserved communities in the Dominican Republic. La Fundación para la Prevención y la Salud bucal de los Niños, Inc. **currently operates ten (10) permanent dental clinics, thirty-seven (37) portable dental units, and a mobile dental clinic permanently stationed in Cabrera**, allowing us to deliver essential oral health services in both established clinical settings and hard-to-reach communities.

Guided by a human-centred approach, our services prioritize prevention, treatment, and education, ensuring every patient is treated with dignity, compassion, and respect.



Across all “Sonrisas” clinics, patients receive a full spectrum of dental services, including preventive and diagnostic care, restorative treatments, prosthetics, specialized procedures, and oral surgery.

In 2025, “Sonrisas” Dental Clinics provided dental care to 96,839 patients; each visit represented not just a clinical procedure, but a meaningful step toward improved health, confidence, and quality of life.



D.R. - "SONRISAS" DENTAL CLINICS

In 2025, La Fundación para la Prevención y la Salud bucal de los Niños Inc. delivered dental care across ten permanent clinic locations in the Dominican Republic. Below is the breakdown of total patients treated per clinic:



D.R. - MOBILE CLINIC – CABRERA

In partnership with a valued Canadian donor who prefers to remain anonymous, the Mobile Clinic in Cabrera continued expanding access to dental care and preventive health services in 2025 for communities with limited access to formal dental facilities.

Through this initiative:

- **4,233 people** received free dental treatments.
- **4,352 families** benefited from oral health education and disease prevention programs.
- A total of **8,585 beneficiaries** were reached through combined dental care and preventive education efforts.

This program plays a critical role in reaching underserved rural populations, reducing untreated dental conditions, and strengthening long-term preventive health practices within families.



D.R. - PRIMARY HEALTHCARE EDUCATION

At “Sonrisas”, care extends beyond the dental chair. Health education is an essential part of our approach, empowering patients with knowledge and tools to maintain long-term oral and overall health. Through hands-on demonstrations, educational sessions, and the distribution of hygiene kits, our teams help patients build lifelong preventive habits.

In 2025, **114,657 patients** were reached through oral and primary healthcare education programs, reinforcing our belief that sustainable impact begins with education and prevention.

A special highlight of this work is the Mobile Dental Clinic in Cabrera, made possible through the generous support of a valued anonymous Canadian donor. This partnership has allowed Smiles Foundation to deliver free dental treatments and vital health education directly to the community, creating lasting change for children, families, and seniors. We are deeply grateful for this continued support, which exemplifies how compassionate partnerships transform lives.



D.R. - “SONRISAS” CAMP

Since 2002, in Pantoja, we have carried out the “Sonrisas” Camp, an initiative that began with just 25 children gathered under a large tree, united by the desire to learn, share, and grow.

Each year, during a dedicated time, the camp provides children with a safe, inspiring environment that combines education, recreation, and values-based learning. Over time, many participants have maintained their connection with Smiles Foundation, becoming committed volunteers and even professionals in the field, including dentists and dental technicians.

In 2025, enrollment reached **50 children**, who continue to learn, develop new skills, and create meaningful memories that strengthen their confidence and future aspirations.



PARTNERSHIPS



In 2025, Smiles Foundation continued its strategic partnership with Zakat Foundation of America to deliver humanitarian assistance to vulnerable communities in the Dominican Republic.

Through this collaboration, we implemented large-scale food distribution initiatives during Ramadan and Udhiya, ensuring culturally appropriate, respectful, and dignified support for families facing food insecurity.



Impact in 2025:

- **2,015 families received Ramadan food packages.**
- **1,730 families benefited from Udhiya meat distribution.**

These programs provided essential nourishment, reinforcing community solidarity while addressing immediate food insecurity among underserved households.



Through this partnership, emergency relief is delivered with compassion, cultural awareness, and dignity that transcends religion.



PARTNERSHIPS



Beyond humanitarian relief, our partnership with Zakat Foundation of America also supports long-term capacity building and economic empowerment initiatives in the Dominican Republic.

In 2025:

- **347 students graduated from the Dental Auxiliary Training Program.**

This program equips participants with professional skills, hands-on training, and certification opportunities, creating pathways toward employment within the dental field and strengthening local healthcare systems.

Many graduates go on to work in our “Sonrisas” dental clinics, directly contributing to the delivery of quality care within their own communities.

By investing in education and workforce development, this initiative fosters sustainable community growth and expands access to quality oral healthcare services.

Together, we are addressing both immediate needs and long-term opportunities, building stronger, healthier futures.



PARTNERSHIPS

In 2025, Smiles Foundation was honoured to receive a generous in-kind donation from Jamieson Laboratories, a recognized Canadian brand known for its high-quality natural vitamins and commitment to preventive health.

Through this contribution, we were able to distribute premium natural supplements to over **5,000 families** in vulnerable communities in the Dominican Republic.

This initiative strengthened preventive health efforts by:

- Supporting overall wellness in underserved populations
- Promoting nutritional supplementation as part of community health education
- Expanding access to essential health resources beyond dental care

In 2025, thanks to the generous support of **The DeBoer Foundation** via **Raymond James Canada Foundation**, Smiles Foundation was able to finally purchase a new generator for our “**Sonrisas**” Clinic in **Moca**, Province of Español.

For **two years**, our local volunteer teams worked tirelessly to raise funds and advocate for this critical need. Their commitment, together with the generosity of our Canadian partners, made this long-awaited investment possible.

In the past, treatments had to be postponed due to power failures and an aging generator that was no longer operational. Today, the Moca clinic can provide uninterrupted care to the communities that need us most, even when the lights go out.

After two years, we finally secured this critical piece of equipment. In a region where frequent power outages disrupt essential services, reliable electricity is vital to delivering safe and uninterrupted dental care.

This investment strengthens our capacity to serve children and families with consistency, safety, and dignity.

Together, we continue building healthier futures; one smile at a time.
